On November 28th, 34 attendees representing 25 Greater Edmonton manufacturers, businesses, and organizations participated in a circular economy-based, business opportunities workshop, part of Canada's National Industrial Symbiosis Program (NISP®). The special facilitation approach used at this event enabled participants to elaborate on their respective waste and resource management challenges, which were in turn shared with all participants. The result: **149 distinct resources were discussed** by the workshop participants, and **189 initial resource matches** were made!
